

Item	Approval of Construction Project Affecting Waterway Safety
Legal Basis	<p>Article 28 of Waterway Law of the People's Republic of China (Order of the President of the People's Republic of China (No. 17) released on December 28, 2014): For construction works related to waterways, the construction shall, in the phase of feasibility study, assess the impact of the construction project on navigation conditions and report to competent transport departments or waterways administrations with review right for review. However, following works are excluded:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (1) Small and medium river control works by riverside or lakeside; (2) Water works built on non-navigable rivers; (3) Works not affecting navigation conditions, including water damage repair and reinforcement of existing water works as well as updates and reconstruction not involving navigation structure or changing original navigation conditions of waterways. <p>If materials about impact assessment of navigation conditions submitted by the construction unit cannot comply with the Regulation, they can be supplemented or modified for review by relevant departments.</p> <p>If the impact assessment of navigation conditions is not carried out or the construction project is considered inconsistent with the Regulation after review by relevant departments, such departments responsible for review or approval shall not approve it and the construction unit shall not build it.</p> <p>Article 29: The impact assessment of navigation conditions of construction projects approved by the State Council or its relevant departments, or related to waterways directly managed by the competent transport department under the State Council shall be reviewed by the competent transport department under the State Council. The impact assessment of navigation conditions of other construction projects shall be reviewed by the competent transport department under the local people's government or waterway administrations at or above county level according to regulations of the people's governments of the provinces, autonomous regions, or municipalities.</p>

Application for Approval of Waterway Construction (other units shall not be required to confirm relevant facts by sealing on the application form);</p> <p>2. Related construction schemes affecting shipping conditions of waterways;</p> <p>3. Identification certificates of the applicant and the agent (the power of attorney is required if the application is filed by the agent).</p> <p>Basis: Not clearly defined in existing laws and regulations and determined by maritime safety administrations based on actual management. Those reviewed shall be used as application requirement.</p>
