Legal Basis	<p>Article 25 of the Regulations of the People’s Republic of China Concerning the Administration of Traffic Safety on Inland Waters (Decree of the State Council, No. 355, issued on June 28, 2002, and revised on January 8, 2011 according to the Decision of the State Council on Amending and Abolishing Certain Administrative Regulations): Anyone who is to carry out the following operations or activities in navigable inland waters or along the banks, which might affect safe navigation in inland waters, shall make a report thereon in advance to the maritime safety authority for approval: (1) exploration, exploitation or explosion; (2) construction, installation, repair or dismantling of structures or facilities at surface or underwater; (3) erection of bridges or cable linkages; (4) laying, servicing or removal of cables or pipelines at surface and underwater; (5) installation of facilities such as mooring buoys, pontoons or bollards etc.; (6) construction of waterways, dredging at waterway or wharf front; (7) holding large mass activities or sports events.</p> <p>If a feasibility study is needed for carrying out the operations or activities listed in the preceding paragraph, the opinions of the maritime safety authority shall be solicited in the study; where, in accordance with the provisions of laws or administrative regulations, such operations or activities need to be approved by other relevant departments, relevant formalities for examination and approval shall be gone through according to law.</p>

Application Form for Review of Safe Navigation of Above Water and Underwater Construction Operations; 2. Approval documents of the project issued by relevant competent departments and their copies (projects needs approval formalities); 3. Technical materials and construction drawings related to safe

navigation;

4 Construction scheme: evidences demonstrating that the safety and pollution prevention responsibility system has been established, and the safeguard measures and emergency plans have been developed.

5. Contracts or agreements related to construction operations and their copies (if necessary);

6. Qualification certificates of the construction unit and their copies;

7. Vessel certificates and certificates of competency of seamen as well as their copies (original copy may not be provided for the moment if it is not within the jurisdictions);

8. Reviewed and qualified assessment report on safe navigation and technical assessment report on environmental impact (having major impact on safety and pollution prevention);

9. Application for issuing navigation notice (or warning) (if necessary);

10. Application for special maintenance (having major impact on safe navigation and pollution prevention);

11. Power of attorney and identification certificates of consignor and consignee and their copies (when there is a commission).

(II) Approval for exploitation, explosion or other activities within the port

1. Application Form for Review of Safe Navigation of Above Water and Underwater Activities;

2. Letter of consent or suggestions on explosion issued by port administrative departments and public security department and their copies (if necessary);

3 Schemes of exploitation and explosion: evidences demonstrating that the safety and pollution prevention responsibility system has been established, and the safeguard measures and emergency plans have been developed.

4. Contracts or agreements related to exploitation and explosion and their copies (not required if the development unit is the construction unit);

5. Qualification certificates of exploitation and explosion units and their copies;

6. List of vessels related to construction;

7. Application for special maintenance (having major impact on safe navigation and pollution prevention);

8. Reviewed and qualified assessment report on safe navigation (having
