

<p style="text-align: center;">Item</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Approval of Posts, Pipelines, Cables and Other Embedded Facilities in Roadside Construction Control Areas</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Legal Basis</p>	<p>1. Article 45 of Highway law of the People's Republic of China (Order of the President of the People's Republic of China, No. 86, July 3, 1997, revised by the Order of the President of the People's Republic of China, No. 57, November 7, 2016): The consent of the department in charge of communications should be obtained beforehand for the construction of facilities which span or cut across roads such as bridges, aqueducts and overhead or underground pipelines as well as for facilities such as overhead or underground pipeline, electric cables, etc. on the right-of-way of highway. If traffic safety will be affected, the consent of the relevant public security authorities must also be obtained. The constructed, erected or buried facilities should meet the road engineering technical standards. Compensation for damage caused to roads should be paid in line with the damages caused.</p> <p>Article 56: It is prohibited to construct buildings or surface structures within the construction control area on either side of roads except for those required for road protection and maintenance. If it is necessary to install underground pipelines or cables in the construction control area, the construction must be approved beforehand by the department in charge of communications of the local people's government above county-level.</p> <p>The extent of the construction control area shall be set by the local people's government above county-level on the principle of ensuring road safety and economic use of land and in accordance with the State Council's regulations.</p> <p>Once the extent of the construction control area is set by the local people's government in accordance with the preceding paragraph, the department in charge of communications of the local people's government above county-level shall erect marking posts and boundary markers. No work unit or individual may damage or move these marking posts and boundary markers without authority.</p> <p>2. Article 27 of Regulations on the Administration of Highway Safety stipulates that before the following highway-related constructions, the constructor shall file the application to the authority in charge of highway administration:</p>

	<p>(1) Occupancy, excavation of highway or its right of way or highway relocation;</p> <p>(2) Construction of facilities which span or cut across roads such as bridges, aqueducts and overhead or underground pipelines;</p> <p>(3) Construction of facilities such as overhead or underground pipeline, electric cables, etc. on the right-of-way of highway;</p> <p>(4) Construction of facilities such as electric cables, etc. with the utilization of highway bridges, tunnels and culverts;</p> <p>(5) Suspension of non-highway signs with the utilization of facilities which span the highways;</p> <p>(6) Extension or renovation of grade crossing on highway;</p> <p>(7) Construction of pipelines, cables and other embedded facilities in roadside construction control areas</p>

Application Requirements or Application Materials	<p>1. Application form, stating the reasons of construction, locations (names of highways, stake numbers and distance to the outskirts or the boundary marker of the highway), safety measures, construction period, highway restoration and renovation measures or compensations;</p> <p>2. Blueprints (including shop drawings and construction plan); if the highway construction control area is involved in the blueprints, the venue rental agreement or official approval shall be provided.</p> <p>Basis: Article 16 of Provisions on Road Administration (Order of Ministry of Transport of the People's Republic of China, No. 81 [2016]).</p>
